We've Got the Moves

MOVEMENTS IN PICKLEBALL. WHEN PLAYING PICKLEBALL THE MOST COMMON MOVES ARE LATERAL MOVEMENTS. THERE ARE OF COURSE FORWARD-BACKWARD MOVEMENTS, BUT THE MAJORITY IS BASED ON LATERAL ACTIONS AT A FAST PACE. THEREFORE, THE SHOES USED WILL HAVE TO PROTECT FROM THIS MOVEMENTS.

Five Basic Rules in Pickle Ball

- BALL MUST STAY IN BOUNDS
- ONE BOUNCE PER SIDE
- SERVE IS AT THE BASELINE
- SERVE CANNOT LAND IN THE VOLLEY ZONE
- GAME ENDS AT 11, 15 OR 21 POINTS
